- Provide two references (one must be from a Grade 12 teacher)
- Provide an electronic copy of their signed university acceptance letter

Response to each question and the applicant's academic performance will be graded (total grading points per question is specified beside each question), and the top eight (8) applicants will be interviewed to choose the final two scholarship recipients. Consolation Scholarships will also be distributed to selected remaining interviewees. **Each applicant's academic performance will be evaluated out of 30 points, and their interview will be evaluated out of 20 points.**
